- SuperHost/Service Excellence/ServiceBest [completed in conjunction with local Tourism Human Resource Office (THRO)]
- Work Placement (240 hours)
- Portfolio
- Exit Interview

## ADDED VALUE

- Internship
- Program achievement distinction

## Method of Application

1. The formal proposal application must be completed by your school board and your high school
2. Application screened by CATT national advisory committee and the provincial/territorial Tourism Human Resource Office (THRO)
3. Formal acceptance or refusal

- High school enrolled with national Canadian Academy of Travel & Tourism office
- Tourism Career Workshop [completed in conjunction with local Tourism Human Resource Office (THRO)]
- SuperHost/Service Excellence/ServiceBest [completed in conjunction with local Tourism Human Resource Office (THRO)]
- Ministry of Education approved secondary provincial tourism career preparation program
- Work placement (100 hours)

OR

- High school enrolled with national Canadian Academy of Travel & Tourism office
- Tourism Career Workshop [completed in conjunction with local Tourism Human Resource Office (THRO)]
- SuperHost/Service Excellence/ServiceBest [completed in conjunction with local Tourism Human Resource Office (THRO)]
- Two provincial/territorial high school tourism or equivalent course/credit requirements (100 -110 hours each)
- Work Placement (100 hours)
- Two other Employability Skill requirements:
  - Tourism Essentials
  - WHIMIS
  - Sanitation Smart Serve
  - Other Food Service
  - First Aid / CPR
  - Workplace Safety
  - Others
