Method of Application

RFP - request for proposal process

1. Complete "Indication of Expression of Interest" (form)
2. Request for Proposal (RFP) (form); the formal proposal application must be completed by your school board and your high school
3. Application screened by CATT national advisory committee and the local Tourism Education Council (TEC)
4. Formal acceptance or refusal communicated
5. Must have 3 year program commitment; no fee required

- Ministry of Education approved secondary provincial tourism career preparation program
- Work placement (100 hours)

OR

- High school enrolled with national Canadian Academy of Travel & Tourism office
- Tourism Career Workshop [completed in conjunction with local Tourism Education Council (TEC)]
- SuperHost/Service Excellence/ServiceBest [completed in conjunction with local Tourism Education Council (TEC)]
